Description: Average height and spread up to 6 metres by 2.5m.

Foliage: Deciduous

Leaves: Green, small, finely toothed leaves ovate to oblong in shape with a rounded base.

Native to UK: No

Did you know?

- Trees can talk to each other through their roots. They pass vital nutrients to help each other to stay healthy and communicate through chemical warnings if there is a threat to the population from a particular pest or disease.
- The trees in front of you are planted in one long trench. This specially designed planting pit has an inbuilt irrigation/aeration system to provide an active soil environment for healthy root development and interaction between the trees for stronger growth.
